Health, Safety & Environment Policy

Everyone working for PROCESS SYSTEMS is responsible for respecting the Health, Safety and Environment rules. The consideration of HSE issues is integral to our development and management strategy. A good performance in these domaines is a deciding factor for the success of our activities.

Our objectives are simple: significantly reduce the frequency and severity of our accidents at work, preserve the security and the health of our employees, and protect the environment. Our policy is based on founding principles applicable for all of our activities :

- Put in place a formal HSE organisation
- Consider the regulations in force to be a minimum requirement
- Identify the risks and evaluate the potential impacts on health, security and environment
- Prevent identified risks
- Use only trained and licensed personnel
- Limit the use of temporary staff to within the capabilities of our leadership
- Inform our employees of the rights for withdrawal in case of uncontrolled risks
- Control our sub-contractors and encourage them to have the same level of HSE management
- Fight against addictions in the workplace (alcohol, drugs...)
- Perform regular HSE assessments in order to keep the HSE policy up to date and to measure the effectiveness of our Management system
- Engage in a process of continuous improvement of our performance via feedback

I commit myself, therefore, without reservation, to put into force for the whole of the Group all necessary actions to attain these objectives as well as the improvement of health and safety and conditions of work.

1 HSE Talk per month per team leader or construction

100% of accidents, near misses and dangerous situations analysed.

1 HSE audit per month in the workshop. 6 HSE audits per year by the site coordinator.
